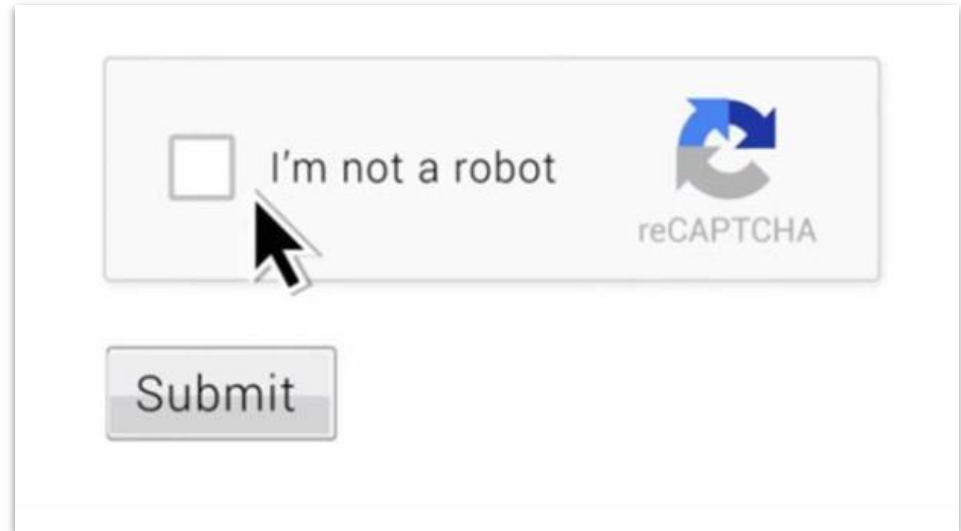


Chapter 1: Artificial Intelligence

In fact can't we take the problem from another angle ?

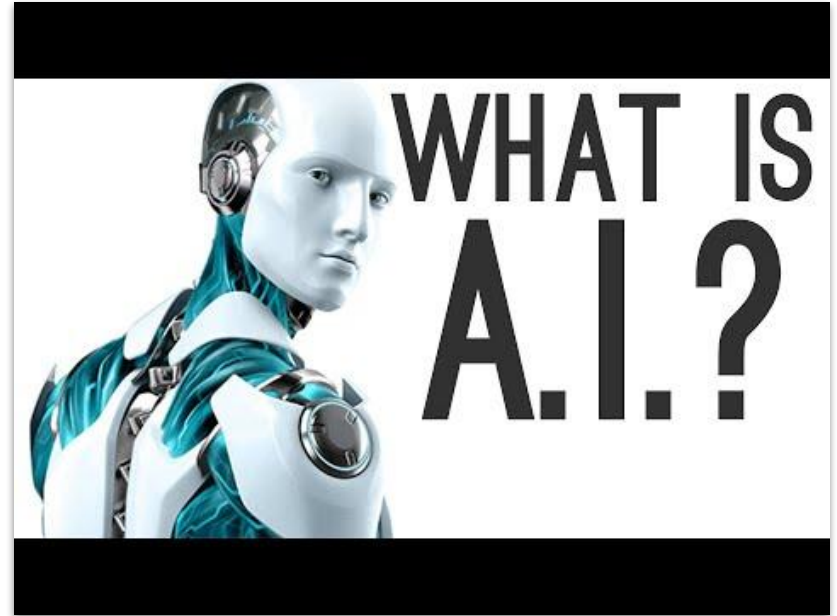
Couldn't we say that *human is a complex machine* ?

Still, this “mise en abyme” ...

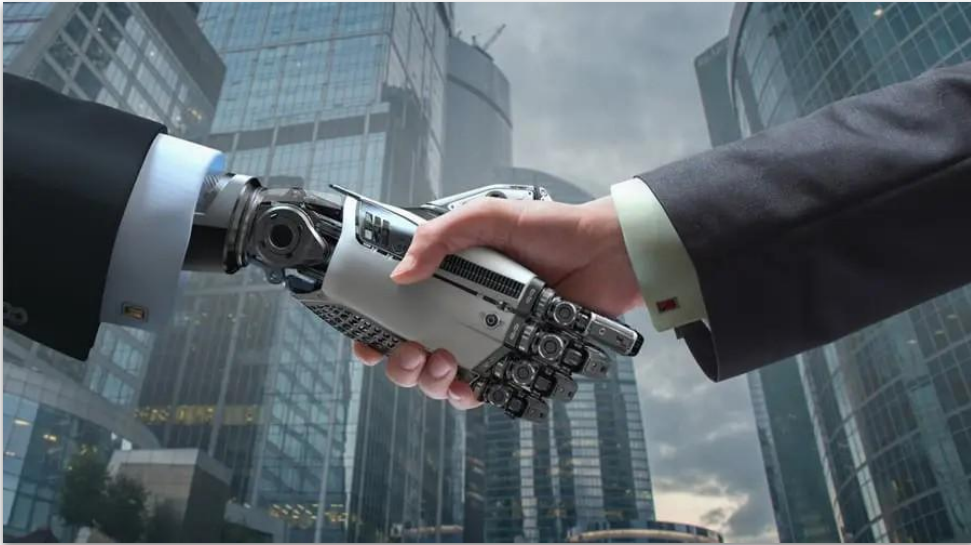
Is a machine able to think ?

So as we saw during the video, **Artificial Intelligence** or **AI** could be defined as a use of computer science to simulate human thoughts by analyzing data.

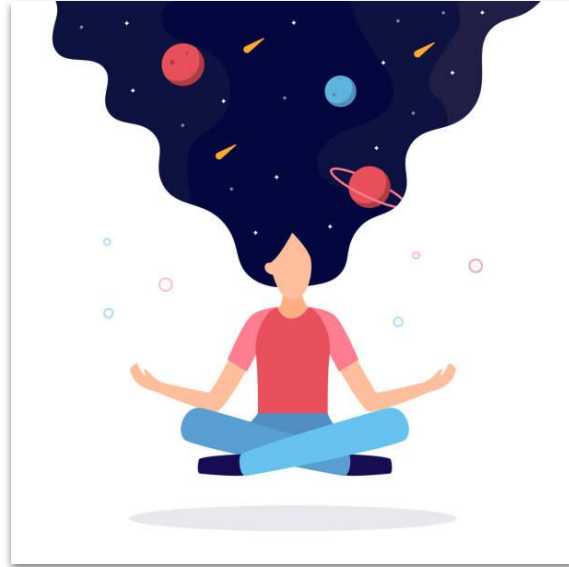


Even though AI still has a long way to go before it achieves what science fiction can show us, the danger of AI is still of human concern.
